RULES

1. **Number of entries in each class limited to two per exhibitor (except Class 23 which is limited to one per exhibitor).**
2. **If there is only one entry in a class, the prize will be left to the judges' discretion. The judges may withhold awards if, in their opinion, exhibits do not reach reasonable standards.**
3. **Please read and interpret the meaning of the schedule to avoid disappointment or disqualification. The judges' decision is final.**

Notes:

- **All exhibitors are on trust that their entries are made by themselves or grown in their own garden in the Wilbrahams or Six Mile Bottom, except flowers in classes 41-48.**
- **Classes 41-43 must have been owned by the Exhibitor for at least 8 weeks**
- **Classes 52-62 are to be exhibited on a white paper plate and covered with cling film or a polythene bag**
- **Classes 63-71 must be Exhibitor's own work and not previously shown**
- **Classes 68-71 must be maximum size 10" x 8"**
