

## Highways Report

*Prepared for the Great Wilbraham Parish Council (GWPC) Meeting to be held on November 17 2016.*

***Since the July report some progress has been made. Two meetings and a Walkabout have been held with the Cambridgeshire County Council Highway's team: the dialogue is ongoing.***

***In summary, Highways have confirmed there are three sources of money we can access to maintain/improve the village highways:***

- ***TDP (Transport Delivery Plan) - three-year programme of work apply for 2017 onwards***
- ***LHI (Local Highways Initiative) - one year rolling initiative apply for next year***
- ***Maintenance - current year***

***The updated status of all the points raised in July and those subsequently added is as follows:***

### Drainage (Flooding)

The two meetings with CCC Highways and residents of Angle End and Church Street have reviewed the drainage issues. A detailed report for Church Street from 2014 was considered and the equivalent report for Angle End is awaited following the recent Gulley Cleanse and Flushing – see below.

The improvement of the village drainage has been proposed for the TDP and the outcome of that application is expected in early 2017.

An additional maintenance project for a soakaway in Angle End has been proposed as a short-term supplement to the drainage improvements included in the TDP application.

### Gulleys

Angle End cleaned and flushed in October – N.B. the drainage outflow ditch now needs redigging.

### Mill Road

This project has been abandoned.

### Angle End kerbs

Completed.

### Ratford Yard kerbs

To be referred to the mobility team.

### Church Street Project

Project due to start early November but has been delayed due to the poor weather.

### Temple End Project

As for Church Street above – the project has been delayed.

#### Station Road Pavement

To be submitted for the 2017 Local Highways Initiative, which closes on 30/11/16. Costs have been requested from Highways.

#### Fulbourn Cycleway

Preliminary village meet was held in September with just 4 people attending and, now the above issues are all in progress, further meetings will be planned.

#### Self help

Insurance details have been supplied and they are to be investigated with a view to encouraging volunteers to help maintain some minor aspects of the village highways infrastructure.

#### High Street/Church Street - added

Works Order raised to repaint the white lines on the sharp bend.

#### Bensteads End Carriageway - added

Patching planned.

#### Angle End Pavement added

Patching planned.

#### High Street Pavement o/s Carpenters – added

Void investigated and subsequently referred to BT.

#### Angle End Pavement o/s No.5 – added

Works Order raised to fill a void.

#### Frog End/High Street ditches

Highways to advise exactly when the ditch was filled.

#### Street sweeping

GWPC to request South Cambs DC for another sweep at a cost of £320 to collect the autumn leaves and to agree a formal programme of periodic sweeping for 2017.

### Village Street Lights

Action: Clerk to continue chasing South Cambs DC.

### Toft way signs

Action: GWPC Chairman to review signage requirement.

### Speeding

Speedwatch activities have lapsed and GW Clerk has issued wheelie bin stickers to residents on Church Street, High Street, Frog End and Station Road.

A letter has been received from a parent who considers speeding to be an issue near the school.

### Street Naming

Chapel Meadows has been adopted as the name for the new development on The Lanes.
