How your comments are used by South Cambridgeshire District Council

Tree Preservation Order (TPO) applications and trees in Conservation Area notices are guite different and you need to bear this in mind when framing your comments which will help in arriving at a decision, but how much will depend on a number of considerations especially the type of application being considered.

TPO application

This is an application for permission to carry out tree work. The Council has the provision to refuse these applications or to approve them subject to conditions. The Council has eight weeks to determine this type of application. If the Council takes longer than eight weeks to make a decision the applicant has the right to lodge an appeal on the grounds of nondetermination. The applicant does not have permission until a decision is made.

<u>Conservation Area tree work notice</u>
This is a prior notification of intent to carry out tree work. The Council does not have the provision to refuse or to apply conditions. The Council has six weeks in which to decide whether to serve a TPO. There are strict criteria governing the making of a new TPO. On the expiry of the six week date the proposed work may be carried out if a TPO has not been made. The Council writes to the applicant informing them of the decision.
