i) S/4471/18/FL Play Area, Wilbrahams' Replacement and new play
Recreational Ground, Memorial Hall equipment in dedicated
Church Street, Great Trustees (fenced) existing play area

C Hanson advised that he had consulted with near neighbours and one neighbour was concerned particularly over the possible increase in noise.

Meeting closed 8.10pm.

E Adams answered members questions on the proposed layout of the equipment in the application. She reported that the survey conducted by the working party had shown strong support for a zip wire. She advised that the location of the zip wire shown is the only possible one and confirmed it is designed for 4 to 12-year olds. She talked members through the rationale of the layout and zoning. Members questioned the safety of the unit. E Adams reassured members that a safety flooring would be put beneath the unit. All members felt that there could be a possible increase in noise. E Adams confirmed that all property owners of near listed buildings had been contacted prior to the submission of the application.

Meeting opened 8.52pm.

Members agreed by a majority vote to SUPPORT the planning application with the following comments: -

The village largely supports the application but there are legitimate concerns from some residents regarding the installation of the zip wire. Members were concerned that parking problems may increase and there would be an increase in noise following the installation of the new equipment.
