The Little Wilbraham Multi Use Games Court

This Multi Use Games Court is provided for the enjoyment of the residents of the Wilbrahams and Six Mile Bottom. Please respect the facilities and make sure we can keep these open for many years. When you book the court or just use it casually, you are agreeing to abide by the Terms & Conditions laid out below.

The court is designed to accommodate the games of tennis and netball and has a basket ball ring at one end. Other games will be added if the demand is there.

The court has no flood lights or drinking fountains so you will need to bring your own refreshments.

The court has been installed based on generous grants from the Wadlow Wind farm Community Trust the Amey Community Fund and the Little Wilbraham and Six Mile Bottom Parish Council.

Terms & Conditions

Right to Play

- 1. Residents of Little Wilbraham, Great Wilbraham and Six Mile Bottom have the right to use the court. Other members of the public can book/use the court if it is free but residents from the three villages named above have precedence.
- 2. Residents of any age or physical ability have the right to use the court or part of the court.
- 3. Use of the court is currently at no cost but the Parish Council reserves the right to introduce a charge for this facility to help with ongoing maintenance or upgrades to the court and surrounding space and facilities.

Booking Rules

- A simple online system is the primary method for booking this facility. Access to this system is via a QR code located at the court entrance or via the Wibrahams Website <u>bit.ly/wilbrahamcourt</u>
- 2. By making a booking you are accepting all terms and conditions relating to the use of the court and its surrounding space and facilities.
- 3. When the court is booked you will be required to provide contact details. This is to enable the Parish Council to contact you for any operational reasons and also for insurance purposes.
- 4. You will receive a confirmation of your booking by email and also a reminder before the due date and time.
- 5. The court can be booked for a maximum period of 2 (two) hours in any one day by an individual or a group.
- 6. If you are late to your booking, this does not alter your end time unless:
 - it is available and
 - you have extended it online as a separate booking.
- Block bookings are possible but only after consultation with the Parish Council (<u>clerklw@wilbrahams.co.uk</u>).
- 8. The Parish Council reserves the right to pre-book the Courts for events, and maintenance.
- 9. The Parish Council has the right to cancel bookings, at their discretion but any bookings will be informed by email of these changes.
- 10. Where a local resident and a member of the public wish to use the court at the same time and the court is NOT booked, then use will be through negotiation of the parties involved. The Parish Council has no part in these negotiations.
- 11. If you need to cancel or reschedule your booking use the links on your confirmation email.

Playing Area Rules

 When using the multi use games court, parents and guardians take full responsibility for the welfare & security of any children who are aged 16 and under.

- 2. Players use the court at their own risk and are asked to apply common sense and be aware of other users of the facilities at all times.
- 3. Smoking is not allowed on the court.
- 4. Football is not allowed to be played on the court. Use the adjacent area.
- 5. Any other activity outside of the officially designated activities of tennis, netball or basketball is generally not allowed *unless* it does not damage or harm the facilities. For example using small trikes or scooters. The use of the facilities for the designated games always takes precedence.
- 6. Residents must wear clean footwear when on court to protect the surface.
- 7. Dogs are not allowed on the court and dog walking is not permitted on the court.
- 8. Please ensure you close the court gate properly when you enter and leave the court
- 9. Please remove everything you take onto the court including all balls and any litter.
- 10. If the netball hoops are used please return these to the designated storage area and make sure the tennis net is correctly reinstalled.
- 11. Please do not play music on the court and any noise should be at controlled levels that does not disturb neighbouring residents.
- 12. Please do not climb or make holes in the fence/gate.
