

Landlord Incentive Scheme



Renting privately in South Cambridgeshire is expensive, and the market is very competitive. Homes for Ukraine refugees are finding it increasingly difficult to secure their own independent accommodation. In response, South Cambridgeshire District Council has launched the Homes for Ukraine Landlord Incentive Scheme.

Landlords who offer a minimum 6-month tenancy on a property in South Cambridgeshire to a Homes for Ukraine family will receive a financial incentive. The amount can be found on the table below. Landlords will also qualify for a further top up payment upon renewing the tenancy and will receive payments for up to 18 months' worth of tenancies.
