Business supports Youth Engagement Programme

Cambridge City Council and South Cambridgeshire District Council have together launched two programmes of work which set out to support market traders. The funding has come from the Government's UK Shared Prosperity Fund which is being administered by the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority. I'm very7 pleased to see this as I sat of the Youth Engagement task and finish group through Scrutiny.

- 20 traders in South Cambridgeshire will be able to access advice and support to enhance their current business operations, and may be eligible to apply for £1,000, grants to help develop their business.
- Meanwhile, a Youth Enterprise Support Programme will support young people who
 want to start their own business, to get started. The <u>programme</u> will work with young
 individuals aged 16-25 to develop essential skills, knowledge and will include
 opportunities to gain real market experience. Candidates will also have the
 opportunity to apply for £1,000 grants to transform their business ideas into local
 market ventures.
