**Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 - Section 14(2) as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991**

**(Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic)**

**Notice 24-1348**

The County of Cambridgeshire hereby gives notice that from 09:20hrs on 6th August 2024, no vehicle shall proceed along Six Mile Bottom Road, Little Wilbraham as lies between Primrose Farm Road and Council Farm.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this Order.

The alternative route for vehicles is via Pit Road, Little Wilbraham Road, Newmarket Road, Bottisham Cycletrack 1, Cambridge To Newmarket Road, Cambridge Road, London Road, Access Road To July Racecourse, Wilbraham Road, Six Mile Bottom Road and vice versa.

This Notice is made in the interest of safety because of emergency electrical fault repairs and will remain effective whilst there is a risk of public danger but not for more than 21 days.

It is anticipated that these works will take place between 09:20hrs 6th August 2024 and 09:20 12th August 2024

The Notice shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
